


What is Pollution Prevention (P2)?

- Protects public and environmental health by preventing pollution from occurring in the first place
- Inspections are proactive, not looking to fine or report violations
- Helps businesses achieve environmental Best Management Practices (BMPs) and understand regulations that apply to them

We All Live Downstream!

- Anything that is placed in the gutter or storm drain will end up back in the water system.
- Spills will hurt your drinking water as well as aquatic life.




Importance of P2 in Salt Lake County

- Drinking water protection (small amount of pollutant can contaminate aquifers)
- Protection of various wetlands, Jordan River, Great Salt Lake, plant and animal communities
- Storm drain system in Salt Lake County all drains to the Jordan River
- Progress has been made on Jordan River water quality, but would you eat a fish from there?

Contains Findings, Violations and an Order


- Requires correction of violations
- Pollution Prevention (P2) plan or inspection plan
- Payment of penalty or recovery of costs
- May include other agency costs
- Requirement to meet with Health Department
- Bonds, Projects, Future Expectations
